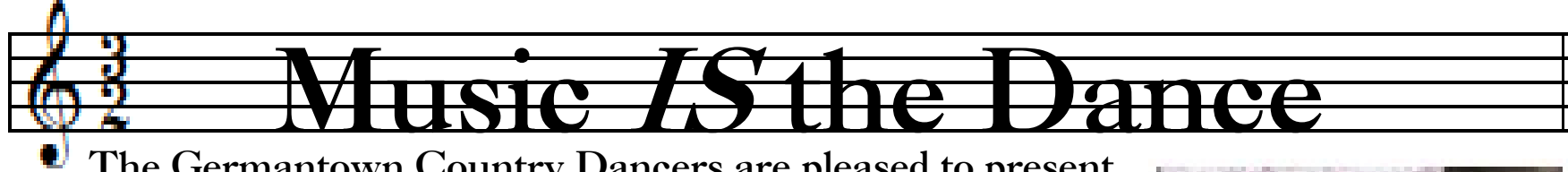


Playing For English Country Dancing:

Chris directed Early Music Week at Pinewoods Camp from 1999 to 2001. Most recently, she completed a 10 year world tour with Cirque du Soleil.
