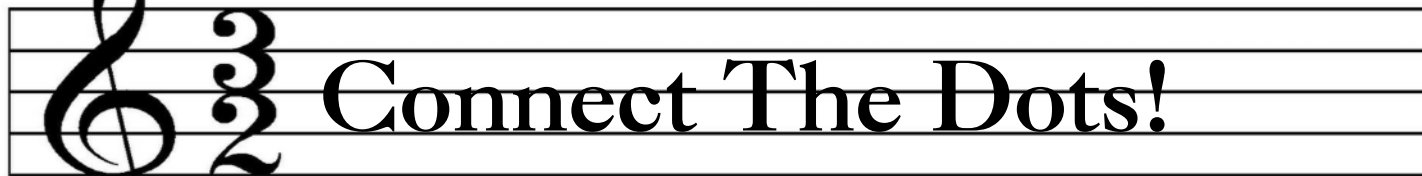


# Playing For English Country Dancing:

## *Connect The Dots!*

In music notation, the little black dots on the page are just the tip of the iceberg. A musician's work on the fundamentals of music - rhythm, tuning, tone, etc. - requires steady application, as does the things these fundamentals make possible - performing, playing in ensembles, playing for dancing, etc. If each day of practice was a dot on a graph and each element was plotted as well, we could see web-like lines created by the daily work. In this workshop, we will work on strategies to create a continuously broadening foundation of musical skills that can be enjoyed by an individual and brought to a group.

This will be a hands-on workshop, so bring an instrument, a notebook or paper and pen, and a recording device or camera. Wear comfortable clothes, bring a water bottle and be ready to work and play!
